The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) has completed its review of Monopole's Monochem Permashield Premium System. The affected division's response indicates that based on field tests both on April 15, 2009 and October 5, 2009, Monochem Permashield Premium System meets the minimum specifications for 502.02.05a ANTI GRAFFITI COATING (PERMANENT NON SACRIFICIAL) with all restrictions removed as previously stated.
