



CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDE

TUB & TILE REFINISH COATINGS

Overview

Tub and tile coatings are designed to refinish and protect bathroom fixtures and wall surfaces, providing a smooth, durable, moisture-resistant finish.

Initial Cure

- Allow at least 24 hours after the finish is dry to the touch before using the tub or shower, as specified in the Technical Data Sheet.
- Limit water exposure, cleaners, or physical contact during the cure period.

Routine Cleaning

- Once cured, clean regularly using non-abrasive bathroom cleaners and soft cloths or sponges.
- Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry when possible.
- Avoid abrasive pads, scouring powders, non-diluted bleach, ammonia, or acidic cleaners.

Moisture Management

- Maintain proper ventilation to reduce humidity and condensation.
- Promptly address plumbing leaks or standing water conditions.

Inspection & Repairs

- Inspect periodically for chips, scratches, or wear.
- Repair damaged areas promptly to prevent moisture intrusion beneath the coating.

Long-Term Care

- Gentle, consistent cleaning significantly extends coating life and appearance.
- Avoid placing sharp or heavy objects directly on coated surfaces.
